

Ambitious Montessori Network Expands To Northern Virginia

LePort Schools, a leading provider of Montessori education in California, has acquired The Boyd School, a family-owned business operating seven Montessori schools in Northern Virginia. LePort will integrate the seven Boyd campuses into its community of schools, creating a bi-coastal network of authentic Montessori programs serving children from infancy through middle school.

"Too often, we've seen schools, built by passionate and idealistic founders, slide into decline or disappear entirely when the owner decides to move on to their next phase in life. LePort Schools itself has grown from a small family operated business of four Montessori schools in 2009, to a professional network of 15 schools serving over 2,000 students. The company has invested significantly in its underlying platform, and is eager to help Montessori schools achieve pedagogical integrity at scale.

"When we started thinking about our next phase in life, we looked far and wide for a partner to whom we'd entrust our life's work and legacy. Someone who'd appreciate the importance of Montessori done well, and someone who would be a missionary for what Montessori classrooms can offer children." says MaryAnn Boyd, founder of The Boyd School. "We're confident that LePort is that partner."

Dr. Maria Montessori opened her first "Children's House" in Rome in 1907. Achieving astounding results, she saw her educational philosophy blossom into a worldwide movement within decades. Yet many parents, even those who are otherwise actively involved in their children's lives, are too often unaware of the benefits a Montessori education can offer. LePort Schools' mission is to change that, and bring Montessori education into the educational mainstream. "Our goal is to demonstrate to the world, in a dramatic way just what is possible when education is done right. We want the world to see what great Montessori looks like, and how it can help children transform their lives for the better," explained Girn. "Montessori should be on the table—in the center of the table, really—any time educational reform is discussed. It is, in my view, the key to an urgently needed educational revolution."
